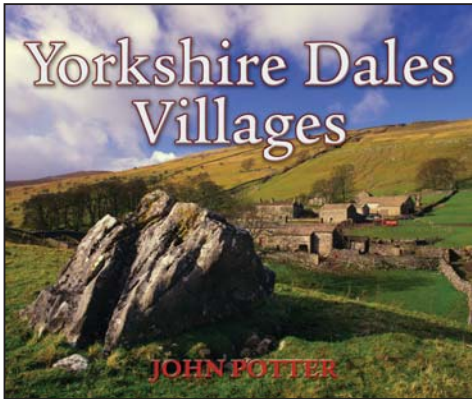
AMBLESIDE

Surrounded by beautiful mountain scenery, Ambleside lies on the main road that runs between Keswick and Kendal. It is much more than a village - it even has its own cinema. Ambleside has a thriving student community at St Martin's College and hosts the Lake District Summer Music Festival.

Ambleside is always busy. Although the streets bristle with shops and cafes, the silent pass just off the road called "the straggle" - the way up to the Rakestone Pass - has some lovely old houses and seems to escape. Pigeon Hill, off North Road, and sharply uphill from back Bridge, is a good place to start.

Bridge House, the ancestral Howarth Trust property, recalls back brick and beyond to the old mill buildings, complete with water wheel, and some a restaurant.

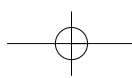
